OMAHA BAD BEAT JACKPOT QUALIFICATIONS & RULES

- Omaha Bad Beat hands only qualify on the tables where the Omaha Bad Beat rake is collected
- The Omaha Bad Beat rake is only collected for hands with pot size equal or greater than \$20 when five or more players are being dealt in a hand
- The minimum qualifying hand is four of a kind eights beaten by four of a kind nines or better
- Qualifying hands must meet the following criteria:
 - Players must use both cards of their four-card hand to complete the five-card hand
 - Kickers do not play
 - Four of a kind will require a player to have a pair in their hole cards
 - The top two hands are the only hands that qualify
- All mucked hands will not qualify for the Omaha Bad Beat Jackpot
- Any discussion of the Bad Beat hand or details of a player's cards during a hand will disqualify the hand for the Omaha Bad Beat Jackpot
- Management reserves the right to make the final decision in cases where the player may interpret differently ejection, suspension and barring.

The fund distribution of the Omaha Bad Beat Jackpot among the players on the table will be:

- 50% to the player with the losing hand (Bad Beat)
- 25% to the player with the best hand (Winning hand)
- 25% to be shared among all active players

The Bad Beat Funds percentage will be as follows:

- 60% to the Bad Beat Main Fund
- 30% to the Bad Beat Seed Fund
- 10% for Administration Fee

THE POKER ROOM

- The Dealer shall rake \$1 towards the Omaha Bad Beat contribution for every pot that is \$20 or more
- The Dealer shall deposit the Omaha Bad Beat rake into a separate Omaha Bad Beat jackpot drop box located on each poker table
- The Omaha Bad Beat Jackpot will be counted and totaled daily
- Valid Government ID is required for all players involved to be paid out
